3 <sup>rd</sup> Column under Initial Dose next to Class Agent – Desipramine	25 mg three times or - 75 mg once a day	25-75 mg once a day or divided
3 <sup>rd</sup> Column under Initial Dose next to Class Agent – Doxepin	25-75 mg daily at bedtime or twice a day	25-75 mg once a day or divided
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Escitalopram	No Change	Avoid: CrCl <20 ml/min
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Fluoxetine	Avoid	No change
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Fluoxetine weekly	10 mg	Avoid
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Paroxetine	12.5 mg	10 mg
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Paroxetine CR	25 mg	12.5 mg
7 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Renal-Across from Class Agent – Sertraline	Blank	No Change
9 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Pregnancy FDA Cat. – Across from Class Agent – Nortriptyline	D	Should be blank
9 <sup>th</sup> Column Under Pregnancy FDA Cat. – Across from Class Agent – Desipramine	C	Should be blank
Asterisks should be beside Nortriptyline and Desipramine under the 1 <sup>st</sup> Column and at the bottom of the chart it should read: *Nortriptyline and Desipramine have not been assigned a pregnancy category by FDA.
